A Florida Postsecondary Comprehensive Transition Program (FPCTP) is an inclusive postsecondary program for students with intellectual disabilities which increases *independent living, inclusive and experiential postsecondary education*, and *employment opportunities*.

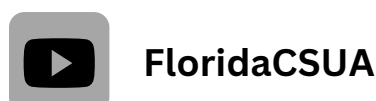
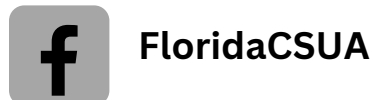
