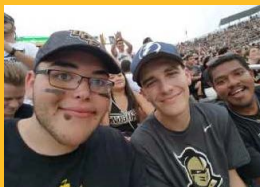

Inclusive Education Services (IES) at the University of Central Florida offers students with intellectual disabilities an inclusive, comprehensive non-degree seeking academic experience.

Our curriculum requires a 2.5-year commitment to complete the student's chosen course of study. IES offers three concentrations from our Professional Services Credential which include: Hospitality, Social Services and Education.

Upon completion of the course of study students will earn a credential through the Division of Continuing Education with the support of the College of Innovation and Community Education.

The IES team concentrates on creating an immersive university experience and provides a range of resources to assist students in successfully navigating and participating in campus life.

Additionally, our team focuses on guiding students toward developing and mastering the necessary skills to pursue and secure meaningful long-term employment.

## IES Admission Criteria

Students with a clearly documented intellectual disability who cannot otherwise traditionally access post-secondary opportunities.

Must have exited K-12 with a standard diploma, special diploma, or certificate of completion.

Personal desire to attend UCF in order to grow professionally and to secure employment after graduation.

Students cannot be under full guardianship or any social guardianship.

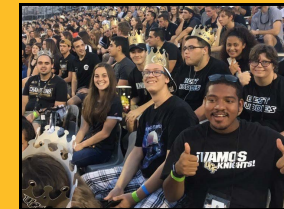
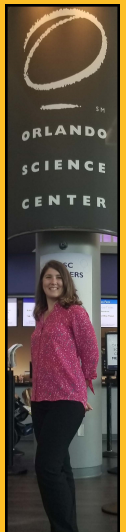
